B)	Introduction of Kimberly Beare: Kirsten Perez, Assistant Superintendent Business Services introduced Kimberly Beare, Communications Coordinator, who joined Morgan Hill Unified in November 2015. She has become a true asset to the district in the short time she has been with us and is working hard to spread the good news of the district. Kimberly said she is available and to contact her if the committee wants any information to be conveyed to the public.		
C)	Expenditure Report: Anessa Espinosa, Director Facilities, reported on the expenditure report and highlighted any changes. Brad Ledwith questioned if every classroom in the district has a smartboard. Anessa explained that we are working on the best option for the different grades. Brad expressed how impressed he was with the technology in the classrooms that teachers have been using in their different lessons. Cristy Geig shared that her child uses his Chromebook constantly and it is working great for them. Roger Beauliea asked if the Chromebook were filtered and Kirsten Perez, Assistant Superintendent Business Services, explained that we do have a filtering system for the Chromebook, on and off campus. Mike Rusch asked if the filter is different for the different grade levels. Kirsten explained that the Chromebook are filtered by broad categories and that we are looking to upgrade web filtering so parents will have the ability to see what their students are searching on the internet. The MPR at the Encinal Site is complete other than the septic. There will be a ground opening and the COC will be invited to that event.


